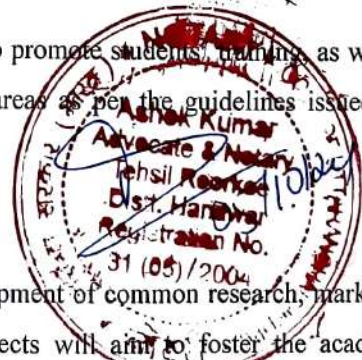
WHEREAS:

The First Party is Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Motherhood University, Roorkee, Haridwar, Uttarakhand-247661 A State Private University, established under the Uttarakhand Government Act No. 05 of 2015, with faculties including Pharmacy, Agriculture, Sciences, and Paramedical and various other courses engaged in life sciences teaching, research, and extension activities. The Second Party is Talwar Pharma, Roorkee, Haridwar, Uttarakhand - 247667 involved in manufacturing of various Pharmaceutical Dosage Forms.

Both parties have agreed to enter into a long-term collaboration to promote students' training, as well as undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD research, in cutting-edge areas as per the guidelines issued and amended from time to time.

Article 1: Scope

The collaboration between the two parties will include the development of common research, marketing programs/projects within their approved disciplines. These projects will aim to foster the academic growth of students, with research objectives differing as far as possible for each student involved.

Head of the Institution of the First Party and the CEO/Director/ Founder of the Second Party will be responsible for working out the operational details of this collaboration and ensuring the proper implementation of this MoU.

A Concerned Committee will meet at least once annually, alternately hosted by the two institutions, to review the ongoing activities. The review will include academic and research presentations, which will be open to students, faculty, and scientists.

Article 3: Exchange of Information

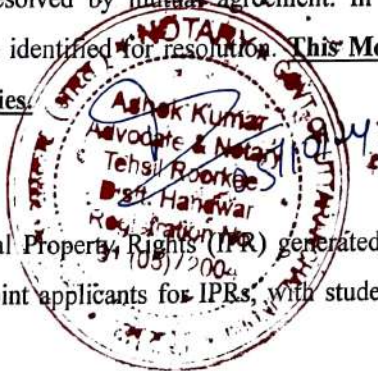
The term "information" covers all scientific or technical data, results, methods of investigation, and other details provided or exchanged under projects initiated in accordance with this MoU. Both parties commit to disseminating information as widely as possible. Each party will retain the right to use, publish, disclose, or disseminate such information for any purpose as part of joint projects.

Article 4: General Provisions

Both parties subscribe to the principles of equal opportunity and non-discrimination based on race, gender, age, caste, or religion. They shall uphold these principles in the administration of these MoU. Financial arrangements for collaborative projects will be negotiated separately, depending on the availability of funds. The exchange of students will similarly depend on available circumstance and funding. Any disagreements related to this MoU will be resolved by mutual agreement. In case of unresolved disputes, a mutually acceptable arbitrator may be identified for resolution. This MoU does not preclude other forms of collaboration between the parties.

Article 5: Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

The both Party shall ensure the protection of any Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) generated during student research under this MoU. Both parties shall act as joint applicants for IPRs, with students and scientific staff included as inventors/authors.

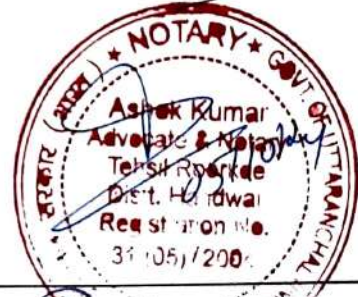
